Carmelkidz Ministry believes that it is important to invest in the next generation of leaders by allowing students in grades 9-12 to serve in Children's Ministry. Being in leadership requires additional responsibilities based on 1Timothy 4:12. All youth leaders and their parents are asked to read the following expectations and commit to each for leadership by signing it.

- **WORSHIP:** As a youth leader, I understand the importance of modeling through my consistent and active participation in Sunday morning services. I have chosen to attend the _____ worship service.
- **WORSHIP:** I understand worship is more than what happens on Sunday morning, and I should worship God with my life and will set my conduct/life style to be an example to the children I serve.
- **CONNECT & GROW:** I understand I need to connect to my peers and grow in my spiritual walk through personal growth. I do understand regular participation in **Fuel** on Sunday night is a part of my leadership requirement.
- **TELL:** Since a part of my responsibility is to tell my personal story of salvation, I understand I am required to show my public profession of faith through baptism.
- **COMMUNICATION:** I understand I am responsible for communicating my schedule to my team leader in advance and will check my e-mail for important messages from my team leader and Carmelkidz Ministry weekly.
- **TEACHING RESPONSIBILITY:** I understand my role as small group leader is vital to children and will be prepared by downloading lessons and following the lesson plans.
- **CHILDREN'S CAMP:** I understand my participation in serving in Children's Ministry will make me eligible to serve as a Children's Camp youth counselor after a minimum of one year's service with outstanding commitment and conduct (listed above). I also understand I need to have completed the 10th grade before I am considered. I also understand I need communicate my desire to serve at Children's Camp in a prompt manner. The director and Carmelkidz ministry will evaluate my eligibility based on my commitment and conduct.

I understand that being Carmelkidz Youth leader requires greater responsibility and commitment on my part. I have read all the requirements listed above and will do my best to represent not only myself, but Christ, to the children I serve and the Student Ministry as a whole, thus I will act above reproach in all aspects of my life.
